

The Great Commission! It's been the church's mission call since the resurrection, and this spring we have an amazing opportunity to put this call into action!

WHAT: Pastor Rick is part of a 15-person work group that will travel to South Dakota's Chanjku Waste Ranch on the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation located in Porcupine, SD, in March to build a 12' x 24' cabin for the camp's 10-week Summer Program for kids. That program showers God's love on at least 150 children each day by offering meals and activities that feed and nourish them spiritually and physically.

WHY: Ogalala Lakota County, where the reservation is located, is the **poorest** in the United States, with a per capita income of \$8,768! The county ranks **last** in South Dakota for health outcomes (length and quality of life) and **last** for health factors (behavior, clinical care, social/economic factors and physical environment).

HOW: Your donations and prayers will put the Great Commission into action in a very real way. Several area churches are raising \$9,300 to cover remaining costs of building materials and to feed/house the team that week. Any amount raised above the \$9,300 will be donated to the ranch's Vision & Dental Clinic. Cash and checks will be gratefully received.
